Foundation Paper Pieced

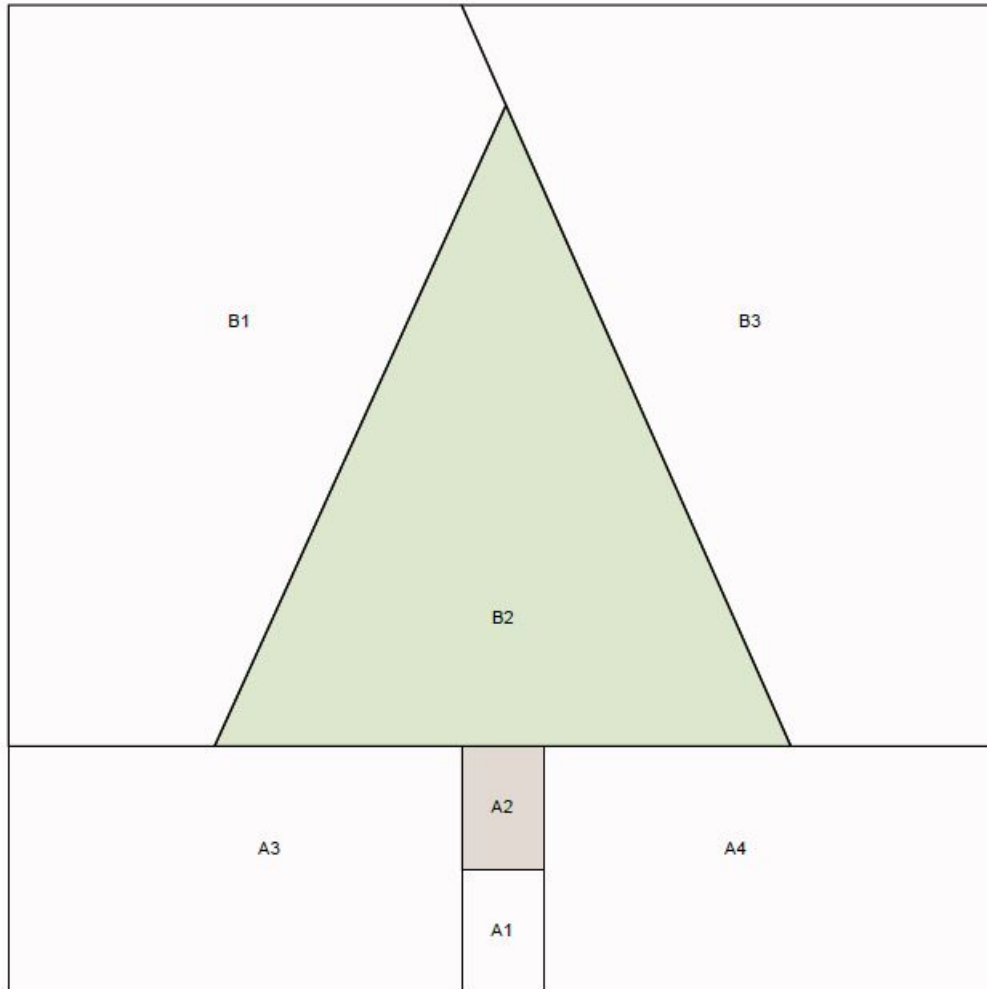
Before you start

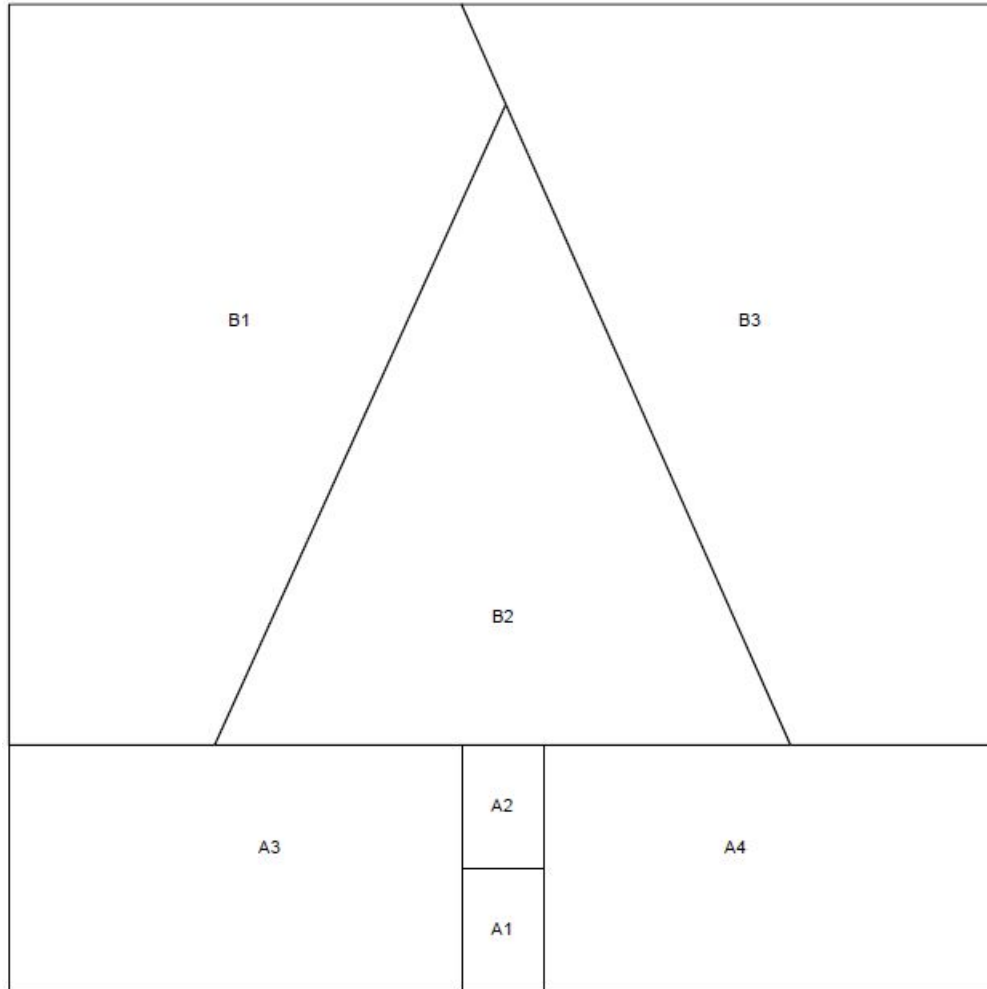
- Knowledge of Foundation Paper Piecing (FPP) is assumed for this pattern.
- When you print the pattern, make sure your printer is set to "100%" or "Actual Size". Check that the test square is 1" on all sides
- The paper pieces include a ¼" seam allowance, which is the dotted line around the pieces. Do not cut this off.
- Remember that the printed pattern will be a mirror image of the finished block.
- Shorten your stitch length to make it easier to tear off the paper.

Instructions

- Print the page of templates and make sure the 1" test square is true to size. There is a set of coloured templates and a set of blank ones. You only need to print one.
- Use the blank colouring diagram to colour in your block, then colour or label the templates the same way. It'll help keep things organized.
- Cut out all the templates on the dotted line.
- The finished block is made up of 2 sections labelled A & B.
 - Piece each section individually, starting with the piece labelled 1 (A1, B1).
 - Sew B to the top of A to complete the block
- The block will finish up at 6.5" x 6.5" with the seam allowance.

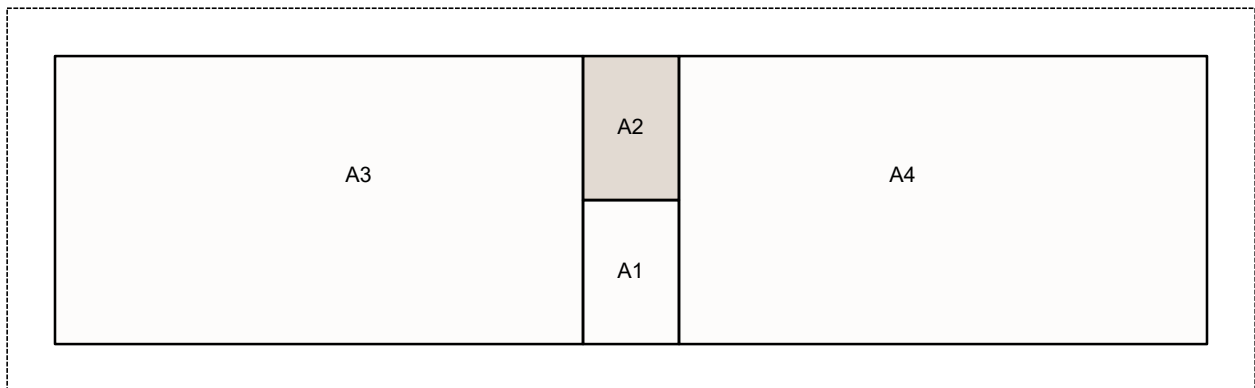
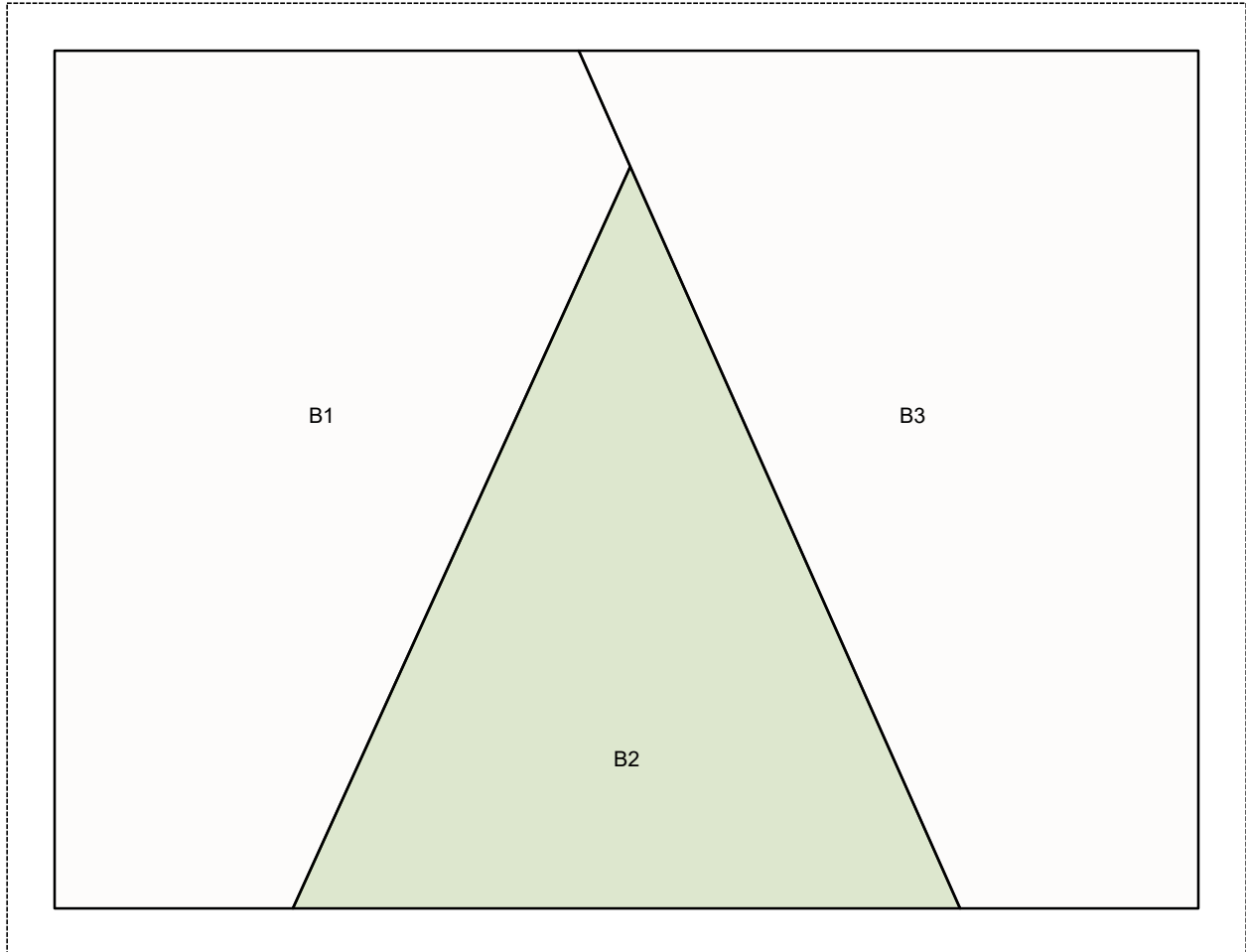
