

# COOKIE MUG ORNAMENT PATTERN

#### **GETTING STARTED**

Print the Cookie Mug Ornament Pattern and measure the 1" test square for accuracy. Do not scale.

### MATERIALS LIST FOR ONE ORNAMENT

- One, 5" sq. holiday print for mug and handle
- One, 4" sq. white felt for whip cream
- One, 4" sq. drink-colored felt for inside cup
- One, 3" sq. light brown felt for gingerbread
- One, 2" sq. stripe print for candy stick
- One, 6" sq. stiffened white felt for backing
- One, 6 x 10" paper-backed fusible web
- Two, 2.5-3mm black buttons or sequins for eyes
- Coordinating threads for sewing machine
- Optional sequins (2.5mm), tiny pom poms, beads, glitter or faux sprinkles for whip cream top
- Optional embroidery floss and needle (if you prefer hand stitched details)

#### TO HANG ORNAMENT

• One, 8" piece floss/twine and needle

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**HELPFUL TOOLS:** Pencil, scissors, appliqué fusing mat or Teflon sheet, pressing sheet, ironing board, iron, water soluble fabric pen and fabric glue

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Place fusible web, paper side up, over Template (A)
- 2. Trace shapes separately. Be sure to include the portion that tucks under a top piece (shown as dashed line)
- 3. Cut out each shape roughly 1/4" away from the traced line
- 4. With traced side up, fuse shape to the WRONG side of chosen fabric following the manufacturer's instructions. Template pieces that will be cut from the same fabric can be placed and fused together
- 5. Cut out each shape along the traced line; label each
- 6. Hold Layout (B) to a light source (such as a sunny window) and align gingerbread and whip cream shapes on top of layout. Trace stitch details onto the front, fabric side of each shape with a water soluble fabric pen
- 7. Using Layout (B) as a guide, arrange pieces together on a fusing mat, tucking edges slightly where indicated on the layered pieces
- 8. One by one, remove the paper backing from each shape and return piece back in place
- 9. Cover layout with a pressing sheet, press with a hot iron and steam to fuse the shapes together; gently press each shape in the layout to ensure all pieces are fused together
- 10. Once cooled, remove the fused shapes from the mat
- 11. Stitch details on gingerbread smile and whip cream
- 12. If desired, stich around shapes approx. ½" away from the outside edge with coordinating threads; leave outside perimeter edge of ornament unstitched for now
- 13. Sew on the buttons for gingerbread eyes (or glue in place)
- 14. Place ornament front onto the stiffened felt square backing; press with iron to adhere together; trim the backing to match the front
- 15. Stitch around the perimeter of ornament approx. ½" away from the outside edge with coordinating thread

# **LOOP FOR HANGING**

Thread a needle with floss piece; insert needle approx. ½"
from the top of the ornament; tie the ends to create a
loop for hanging
